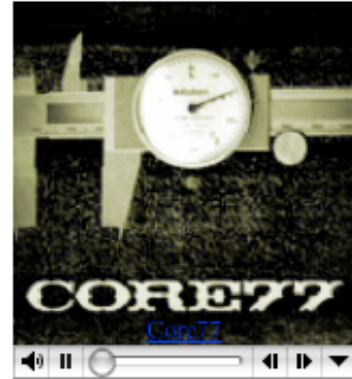


## Podcast research

In class today, listen to your assigned podcast.

While you are listening to the show take notes and think about visual images that could illustrate what is being discussed. You can stop, pause and rewind the podcast if necessary.

Your job will be to put together a visual presentation in Keynote, using images to represent concepts and ideas delivered in the podcast. You will make a slideshow in Keynote of at least 20 images representing vital concepts and ideas from your assigned podcast. You will gather your images from the web. Use the image capture command (Apple + shift + 4) to grab parts of pages, or just click and drag images to your desktop from web resources. (Apple + shift + 3) captures the entire desktop.
